How Do I Begin Bag Collection Service?

Call CleanScapes at (206) 250-7500 to establish service:

- ▶ Confirm contact information.
- ▶ Determine bag collection location.
- ▶ Place your first bag order.

Your bags will arrive by March 20 if you call before March 16, 2009.

How Does Bag Collection Service Work?

Use your bags to collect garbage (green bags), recyclables (clear or blue bags) and food waste (orange bags).

- ▶ Fill bags full
- ▶ Tie bags closed using bag corners.
- ▶ Set full bags in your alley anytime, except between 2 pm and 5 pm.
- ▶ CleanScapes collects bags daily, up to four times each day.

Important: To get the most from this service, fill bags full before tying them closed. Limit 40 lbs in a 33 gallon bag.

Bag Orders and Payment

After you register your account online:

- ▶ Order bags online at www.CleanScapes.com.
- ▶ Bags will be delivered via UPS, two-day service.
- ▶ Invoices for bags will be sent monthly.

Services

- ▶ **Bag Service** is available for garbage, recycling and food waste.
- ▶ **Cardboard** is collected for free. Flatten and bundle cardboard or put it inside an unflattened box.
- ▶ **Used Cooking Oil** is collected for free when put back in original container with tight fitting lid.
- ▶ **Large or Odd-Sized Items**
 - Put a "special pick up" tag on items less than 60 lbs. Order tags online.
 - Call (206) 250-7500 for large bulky item collection.

Setting Out Your CleanScapes Bags

Usando sus bolsas de CleanScapes



- 1 Tie bag closed using bag corners.
Ate la bolsa usando las esquinas de la bolsa.



- 2 Set full bags in your alley collection location.
Ponga las bolsas llenas en el área de recogida de su callejón.



- 3 Flatten and bundle cardboard or put it inside an unflattened box.
Aplane y ate el cartón en bulto o póngalo dentro de una caja.



DO NOT SET OUT NON-CLEANSCAPES BAGS.
Por favor, no deposite bolsas que no sean de CleanScapes.



DO NOT SET OUT UNTIED BAGS.
No saque bolsas abiertas, sin atarlas.



DO NOT SET OUT UNFLATTENED OR UNBUNDLED BOXES.
Por favor, no deposite cajas de cartón que no estén aplanadas o atadas.

TIPS

- ▶ Clear Alleys customers pay by the bag. To get the most from this service, fill bags full before tying off.
- ▶ Food waste and recycling bags are cheaper than garbage bags. Minimize your costs by recycling or composting.
- ▶ The cost of service is included in the value of a CleanScapes bag. Keep unused bags in a secure location.
